Success for All Middle Schools in Pennsylvania Gain on PSSA – Reading

Pennsylvania middle schools implementing Success for All made outstanding gains on the Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (PSSA) – Reading test. **From 2007 to 2010, Pennsylvania schools implementing Success for All had an 11.7 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 6–8 who scored at proficient and above.** Overall, Pennsylvania schools increased by 0.2 percentage points.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- West Oak Lane Charter in Philadelphia: 28.3%
- Steelton-Highspire High School (middle school grades) in Steelton-Highspire: 15.2%
- Lebanon Middle School in Lebanon: 13.3%
- Edgar Fahs Smith Middle School in York: 14.8%
