

## Success for All Middle Schools in Florida Gain on FCAT – Reading

Florida middle schools implementing Success for All made significant progress on the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT) – Reading scale. **From 2006 to 2009, Florida middle schools implementing Success for All had a 5.4 percentage-point increase in the number of students in grades 6–8 who scored at or above Achievement Level 3.** Other Florida middle schools gained 1.0 percentage point.

Schools that made outstanding gains for this period include:

- Millennium Middle School in Seminole County: **10.7%**
- Sanford Middle School in Seminole County: **10.3%**
- Q. I. Roberts Middle School in Putnam County: **9.7%**
- Lawton Chiles Middle School in Seminole County: **9.0%**
