What does a school with Getting Along Together 1st Edition have to do to switch to Getting Along Together 2nd Edition?

Although Getting Along Together 2nd Edition shares some terms and structures with the old GAT, none of the materials transfer. There is also a much stronger schoolwide perspective in GAT2. Therefore, materials should be ordered for each classroom and schoolwide location. There are many different components, including Cool Kid, weekly lessons, class council, new media, and many new terms and expectations. These will all be covered in the one-day program introduction. All staff members, even beyond classroom teachers, should attend the program introduction. Consult with your SFAF coach to determine your materials and training needs.

Cooperative Culture Team

Research strongly supports the concept that students who experience a warm, engaging, and supportive environment are more successful academically. A positive school climate is supportive of staff and promotes greater student growth. The Cooperative Culture team focuses on building structures that encourage positive student behavior along with teaching and encouraging cooperative-learning skills that make a difference schoolwide and in the classroom; this includes supporting homeroom teachers with use of the Getting Along Together lessons and ongoing structures. Consistent and skill-building interventions are used to address schoolwide, large-group, and classroom issues.

Getting Along Together 2nd Edition

The Getting Along Together 2nd Edition (GAT2) year-long program provides instruction and practice in cognitive-regulation and social problem-solving skills for students in grades 1–5. During the first two weeks of school, students have daily lessons in active listening, conflict-resolution skills, and strategies to improve focus, memory, and self-control. These skills are keys to effective teamwork in all Success for All Foundation programs. Throughout the rest of the year, GAT2 includes lessons in empathy, friendship skills, cognitive skills, and common social problems. Training is provided for the school staff—from the main office to the cafeteria—which continues to set the stage for successful conflict resolution in the classroom and beyond.
